Deliverable Instructions

If you have an established partnership with your school district, LCAP and LCFF can be valuable discussion points for identifying funding opportunities for KOHA. It is essential to approach this conversation with thoughtful care and sensitivity.

What Is the Local Control Accountability Plan?

The local control accountability plan ([LCAP](#)) is a tool to assist local-level schools with developing a three-year plan that describes the goals, actions, services, and expenditures needed to support positive student outcomes that address state and local priorities.

What is the Local Control Funding Formula?

Enacted in 2013, the local control funding formula ([LCFF](#)) describes the statewide school funding formula, performance measurements, and services and supports provided to schools to help students succeed. LCFF gives schools the flexibility to spend money on school priorities. Student engagement and chronic absenteeism are listed as one (1) of the state's eight (8) priorities where oral health is positioned to lift students to be healthier and ready to learn.
