Situation

Children's Dental Disease Prevention Program, Health and Safety Code 104770. (1996)

► Kindergarten Oral Health Assessment, AB 1433 (2007)

Background

- Profound disparities in oral health outcomes and underutilization of preventive services
- > #1 reason for school absenteeism
- Gap: Referral Management System to link children to a dental home

Common Cause & Shared Goals

- State Oral Health Plan
 - Reduce tooth decay and untreated tooth decay
 - Increase dental sealant prevalence
- Moving CA Oral Health Forward Grant Program 2022-2027
 - Reduce racial and ethnic disparities in oral health among 3rd grade children by 50% by 2030
- Cal/AIM 60% dental utilization rate for Medi-Cal eligible children
 - SFY 22 Baseline: 46%
- California Department of Education
 - Reducing California's high chronic absenteeism rates is a priority in the Local Control and Accountability Plan

Assessment

- Support for Local Health Jurisdiction \$18 million/year
- Implement a school-linked/based dental programs in 4635 high-need elementary schools
- Procure an Electronic Referral Management System and link children to a source of dental care (dental home)
- Cal/AIM incentive payment to providers to establish a dental home-\$55/year and additional 75% of Schedule Maximum Allowance (SMA)




Kindergarten Oral Health Assessment

Percentage of School Districts Participating in KOHA




Percentage of Children with Kindergarten Oral Health Assessment (KOHA)

Recommendations



- Create cross-sector collaborations to promote dental programs in 4635 eligible elementary schools
- State school dental referral management system: procure, provide training, and track performance
- Leverage Medicaid Federal Financial Participation (FFP)
- Explore ways to obtain dental benefit coverage information from parents
- Encourage SED Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) to include KOHA activities
