DIFFICULT TO ENGAGE PROVIDERS FOR ADVISORY COMMITTEE, ONLY THROUGH MINUTES, NEWSLETTERS, EMAILS, BEING FLEXIBLE IS KEY, OVER~COMMUNICATE AND GIVE CLEAR ROLES, RDHS, RDAS, MPHS CAN HELP

Fresno County- Set clear expectations on who will be leading objectives. Quarterly updates provided by partners. Remind partners of mission/vision and roles. Yolo County- Challenges on how to move w

Provide food at meetings, executive leaders at the meetings who can make decisions on the spot, recruitment plan to define roles, diverse stakeholders, templates for tracking/accountability

Being honest about availability and capacity of LOHP.

Tehema County- Active and engaged tribal centers. Book/ bike baskets to recruit providers for OHAC.

Using google docs, going through strategic process with everyone and share needs assessment data for planning/discussions, sharing LOHP work plan with AC to integrate into partner work plans.

NDHM in Oct- feature an RDHs story and where they work.

Reach more schools. Educating parents. Outreach to parents community schools child care. Clear goals n roles with schools and providers. Sharing data. Common purpose. Accountability. Newsletters.

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Community leaders who were in charge of our leadership or workgroups aren't always in agreement of the vision

Find out baseline/ where are ppl and partners @; identify the value or ROI for them; may require the work to start with something else or another priority to establish relationships; flexible in appro

Clear about limitations and intention to have mutually reinforcing activities
Continued communication and action

Overcommunicate, meet with partners about work plan, circle back with results and updates, incorporate school administration, make phone calls, make AC feel like they have a stake.
