A. Training Plan

It emphasizes the importance of clear communication, practicing cultural humility, and fostering a welcome environment for patients. Designed for versatility, the toolkit provides actionable strategies to incorporate health literacy into any dental care setting.

Deliverable Instructions

Step 1: Identify Key Partners

Key partners may include but not limited to:

Step 2: Training Topics:

Potential training areas may cover a variety of essential subjects, including but not limited to:

- Oral hygiene techniques
- Nutrition's role in oral health
- Toothbrushing practices for early education and childcare settings
- Application of fluoride varnish
- Education on dental sealants
- Conducting oral health assessments
- Counseling to promote better oral health habits
- Facilitating linkage to care systems
- Case management strategies
- Use of Oral Health Literacy Campaign materials/toolkits

Step 3: Implement training*

When implementing training, consider these essential questions:

- **Audience:** Who are you focusing on with this training?
- **Key Message:** What main points and takeaways do you aim to communicate?
- **Curriculum/Materials:** What resources or curriculum will you rely on for the training sessions?
- **Mode of Delivery:** Will the training be conducted virtually, in person, or a combination of both?
- **Facilitator Role:** Are you leading the training as the facilitator, or will someone else take on this role?
- **Train-the-Trainer Approach:** Are you preparing trainers to carry out future sessions?
- **Printing Needs:** Do you need physical copies of training materials for participants? Do you need a sign in sheet to document attendees? Do you have an evaluation form/survey link to assess the training?
