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
Key Grant Outcomes




The California Smile Survey, 2006 and COHP 2028 Target






Kindergarten Assessment Requirement Policy

- Conduct research






California Kindergarten Oral Health Assessment Participation Rate by County, 2017







Dental Sealant Prevalence in 3rd Grade Children








National – Prevalence in 6-11 year old children in the 2011-2014 survey



Local Oral Health Programs can:

- Inform and educate parents, providers and policy makers.
- Target school-based sealant programs to areas where children are at higher risk for cavities and facilitate the establishment of programs.
- Track the number of schools and children participating in sealant programs.
- Identify funding sources that support school-based sealant programs and communicate them to providers in the community.
- Help schools connect to dental providers in the community.

Preventive Dental Visit (%)in Children National Health Survey of Children (1-17 Years)






Preventive Dental Visit (%) among Children enrolled in the Medi Cal Program (0-20 years)






Dental Visit (%) during Pregnancy






Emergency room dental visits for non-traumatic conditions per 100,000
