Opportunity to Improve Oral Health Outcomes



CHW services may address:

- the control and prevention of chronic sexual and reproductive health • conditions or infectious diseases
- oral health •
- need for preventive services
- child health and development •
- mental health conditions and substance use disorders
- perinatal health conditions ٠

- environmental and climate-sensitive • health issues
- aging
- injury
- domestic violence
 - violence prevention





Covered Services

Health Education - may include coaching and goal-setting to improve a beneficiary's health or ability to self-manage health conditions.

to provide information, training, referrals, or support to assist Health Navigation - beneficiaries to:

> Access health care, understand the health care system, or engage in their own care

 Connect to community resources necessary to promote health; address barriers, including connecting to medical translation/interpretation or transportation services; or address health-related social needs

Covered Services

Screening & Assessment -

that does not require a license

Individual Support & Advocacy -

that assists a beneficiary to prevent the onset or exacerbation of a health condition

Billing codes

The following CPT codes may be used for all services listed above by the supervising provider when submitting claims:

CPT code	Description	Length	Number of Patients	Rate
98960	self-management education and training, face-to-face, 30 minutes	30 minutes	1	\$26.66
98961	self-management education and training, face-to-face, 30 minutes	30 minutes	2-4	\$12.66
98962	self-management education and training, face-to-face, 30 minutes	30 minutes	5-8	\$9.46

Currently

- State CHW/P/R certificate on hold seeking input from workforce through June 2024
- The benefit as outlined in the CHW Provider Manual and the DHCS All Plan Letter of September 18, 2023 remains in place.

CHW/P/Rs seeking Medi-Cal reimbursement for their services mustDemonstrate minimum qualifications via 1) a certificate of completion or2) work experience (2,000 hours);

Have lived experience that aligns with and provides a connection between the CHW and the community or population being served; and,

Be supervised by a licensed provider, clinic, hospital, CBO, or Local Health Jurisdiction who is enrolled in the Medi-Cal program.

What Can I Do?

- Ask your Medi-Cal Managed Care Plan(s) if and how they have educated their provider networks and members about the Community Health Worker benefit and how to use it.
- Request written information, webinar materials, etc. from your Medi-Cal Managed Care Plan(s) that they might have developed about the benefit to share with your networks.

BONUS! MCPs also required to:

(1) Provide dental screenings for every eligible beneficiary as a part of the beneficiary's initial health assessment.

(2) Ensure that an eligible beneficiary is referred to an appropriate Medi-Cal dental provider.

(3) Identify plan liaisons available to dental managed care contractors and dental fee-for-service contractors to assist with referrals to health plan covered services.
