Jennifer Felner is an associate professor in the School of Public Health at San Diego State University (SDSU) and a core investigator in the Institute for Behavioral and Community Health at SDSU. Her community-engaged research examines and intervenes on the root causes of health inequities, with an emphasis on promoting the health and well-being of LGBTQ+ youth and youth and adults experiencing homelessness. Specific areas of focus include addressing tobacco and substance use inequities, and housing and sanitation justice. Jennifer prioritizes research that involves collaborating with community members, service providers, and public health professionals as equitable partners, and leverages critical, action-oriented research approaches to build and sustain community power to advance health equity and justice.
